Beginning this September, we will launch the Institute's first online program—a parttime curriculum focusing on Bible Survey and Systematic Theology, with a heavy emphasis on discipleship and building strong relationships with the local church. We pray that the Lord will use these classes not only to sanctify Latin American churches, but also to bring many men into the deeper pastoral training that we and our other training centers offer.
